## About “Mary’s Creek”

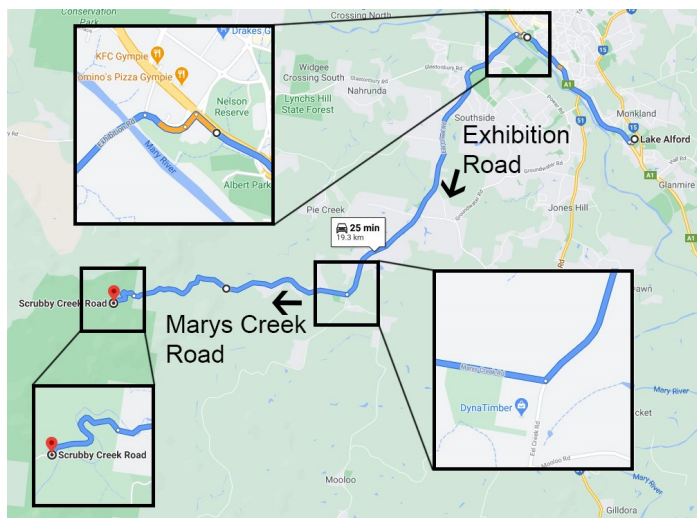

Habitats range from Farmland, Grasslands, & Dams, to Riparian, Rainforest & Open Forest. Virgin scrub still exists on these properties, making the area a haven for birdlife.

Mary’s Creek is situated in a managed State Forest, so please abide by any restrictions as displayed in signage.

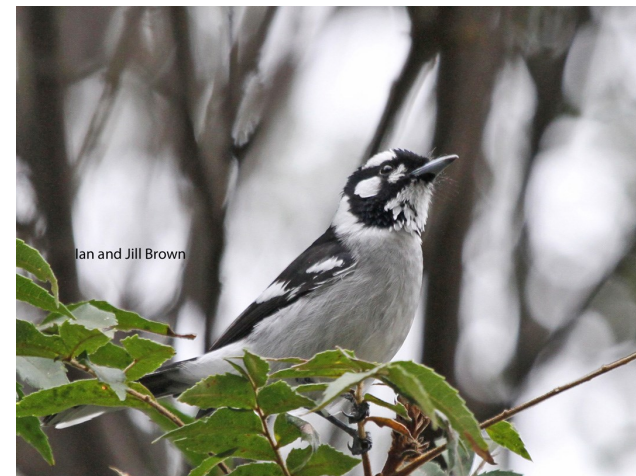
