Food - Seeds and various food scraps.

Nest style - Platform.

Material used - Sticks and twigs.

Nest Site - In trees or shrubs.

Breeding Season & Details - October to January generally, but extending into other periods.

Habits - Frequenting urban and closely settled rural areas, it feeds on the ground in fowl yards, picnic areas, & parks. In some regions, it has spread into bushland bordering settled areas.
